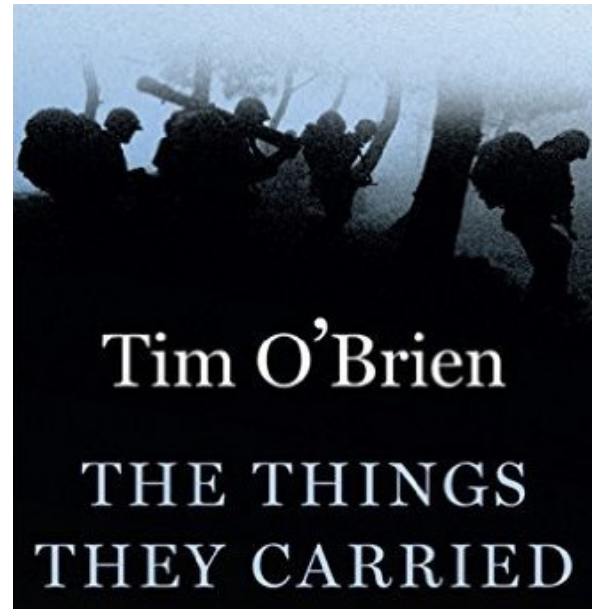


## Ignite Stories with The Big Read

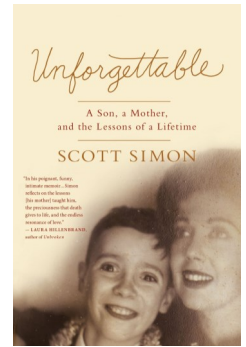
