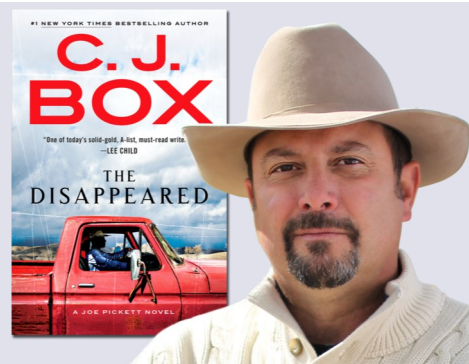


## Mapping the Journey: A Caregiver Workshop
