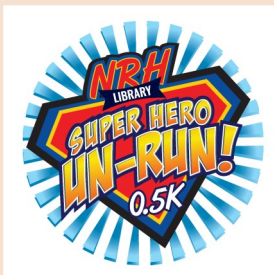

## New Library Catalog System

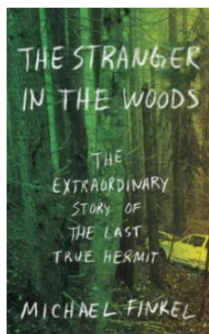
On May 20, the Library will be updating our catalog system. The new system has features that will improve your library experience. Highlights include:

The Third Wednesday of Each Month at 1:00 p.m. in the Library Board Room

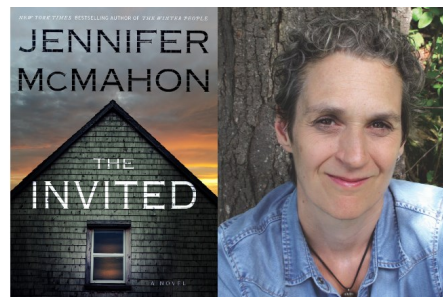
Like to read? Want to make new friends? Join us for Book Break,
