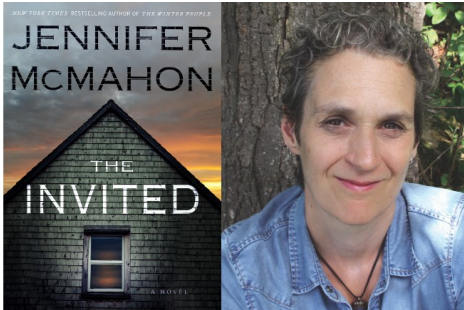

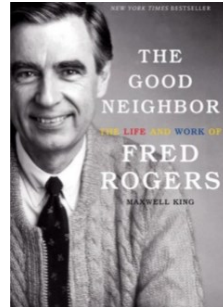
Behind the Book with Jennifer McMahon

New Library Catalog System

On May 20, we will be transitioning to a new catalog system that will provide improved patron experiences. However, as part of this change, we will no longer be members of the North Texas Library Consortium.

As of Wednesday, May 1 our library will no longer borrow from consortium libraries through the catalog. We will continue to issue TexShare cards and provide Interlibrary Loan (ILL) services, giving access to materials from libraries across the state and country. Last year, we simplified our ILL process so that you may request ILLs 24 hours a day/7 days a week, using our convenient online form found at <http://www.library.nrhtx.com/ILL>.

If you are currently saving your reading history, this will be retained; however, any reading lists you have created will not. Passwords will change to the last 4 digits of your card number.

Autorenewal - Checked out items that do not have any holds on them will automatically renew!
