

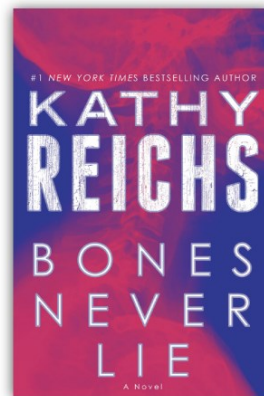
Dr. Kathy Reichs Author Event

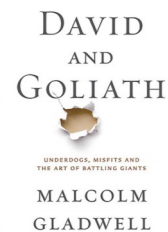
