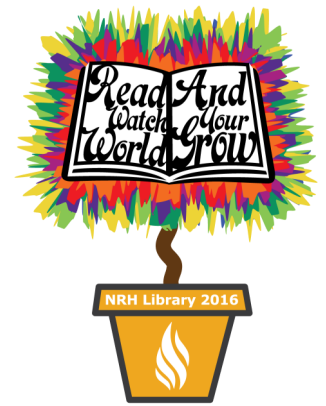

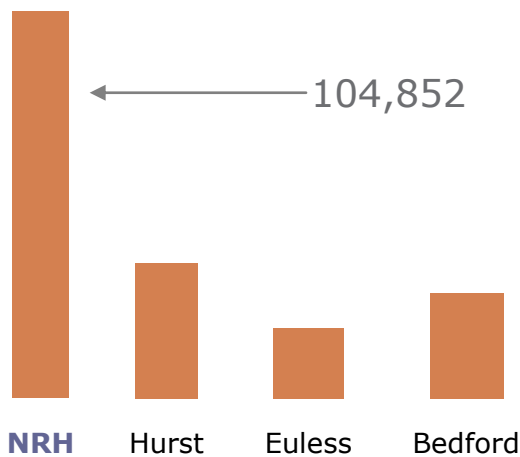

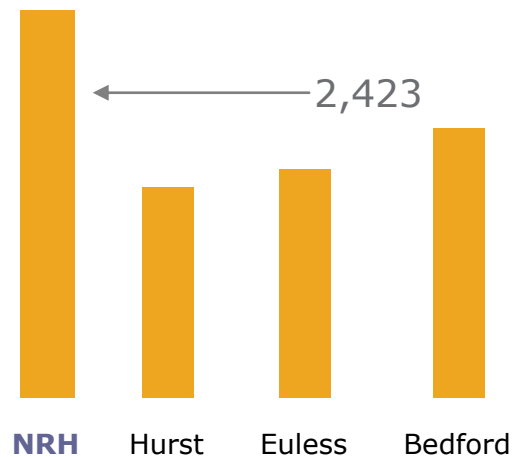


Peer Comparison

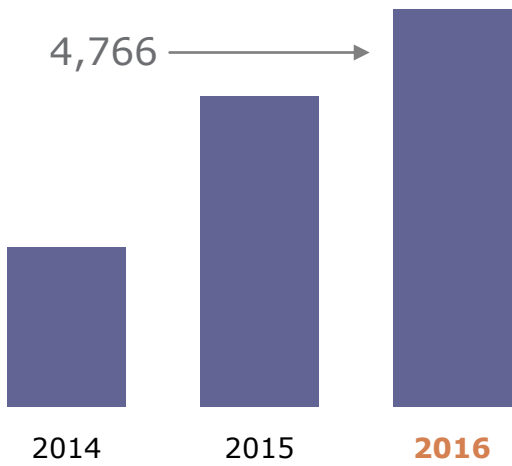
Total Hours Read



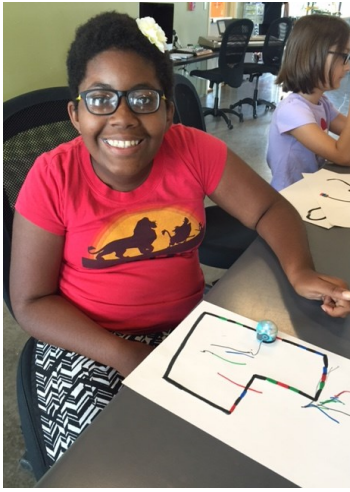
Total Participants

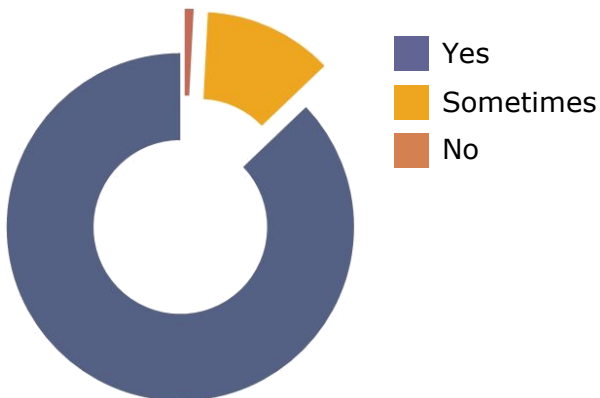

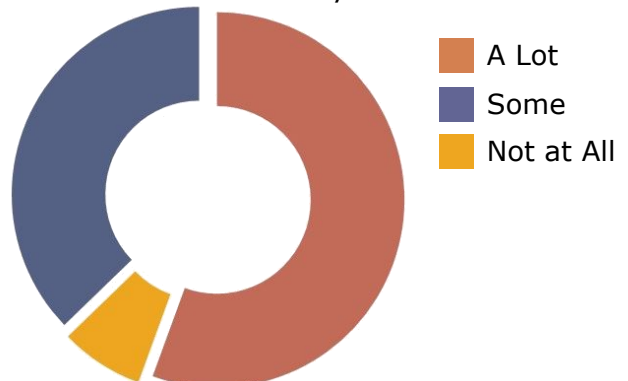
