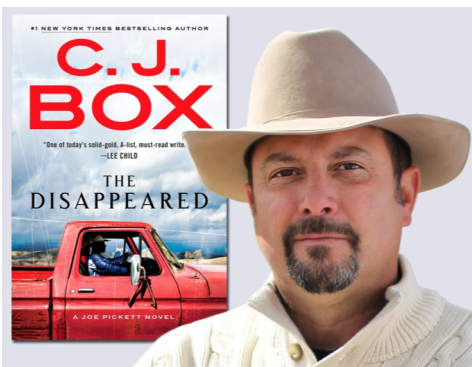

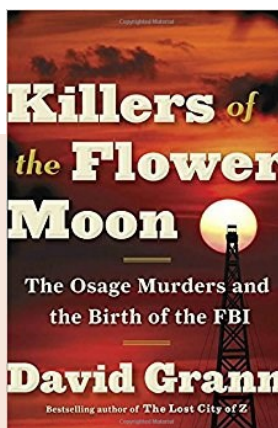
## Toddler Time
