Trained AARP volunteers will assist in electronic filing of the 1040 tax form and basic schedules for taxpayers of any age.

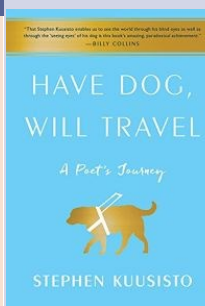
