## Library Express: Curbside Delivery Service

Stay warm and cozy in your car while we bring your items from the holds shelf directly to you!

### How It Works:

1. Place items on hold from the Library's catalog at least 24 hours in advance.
2. Wait for a notification letting you know that your item(s) are available for pickup.
3. Park on the Grand Avenue side of the Library and call the Circulation Desk at 817-427-6800.
4. Provide the staff on the phone with your Library card number or driver's license number, along with the color, make, and model of your car.
6. Library staff will bring up to 20 items from your hold list to your car.





# Meet Bestselling Authors at Your Library!




**December 10 • 1:00 PM**
